IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- Examination Schedule:** The examinations will commence from 15th September 2026 as per the schedule given above. Students must strictly follow the date and subject-wise schedule.
- Clearance of Dues:** Parents must clear all pending dues up to the 2nd Term before the commencement of the examination and collect the Permission Card from the Accounts Department.
- Permission Card & Identity Card:** The Permission Card and School Identity Card are mandatory for appearing in the examination. No student will be permitted to appear without the required documents.
- Reporting Time:** Students must report to school/examination room at least 30 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the examination. Late arrival may result in denial of entry as per school rules.
- Uniform & Discipline:** Students must come in proper school uniform and maintain complete discipline, silence and decorum throughout the examination.
- Stationery:** Students must bring their own required stationery and permitted examination material. Borrowing or sharing of stationery will not be permitted.
- Electronic Devices:** Mobile phones, smart watches, earphones, Bluetooth devices, cameras and all other electronic/communication devices are strictly prohibited in the examination premises.
- Unfair Means:** Copying, carrying notes or prohibited material, communicating with another candidate, receiving/giving assistance, impersonation or any other unfair means will invite strict disciplinary action.
- Question Paper & Answer Sheet:** Students must follow all instructions given by the invigilator regarding the question paper and answer sheet. No page of the answer sheet may be torn, removed or damaged.
- Examination Hall Conduct:** Students must maintain complete silence and must not communicate with or disturb any other candidate during the examination. All instructions of the invigilator must be followed strictly.
- Reading/Working Time:** Students must strictly observe the prescribed examination duration and any reading time/instructions announced by the invigilator. No student will be permitted to continue writing beyond the allotted time.
- No Pre/Post Examination:** No pre-examination or post-examination activity/re-test will be conducted, except in cases specifically approved by the School Management/Principal on valid and documented grounds.
- Absence from Examination:** Absence from an examination must be supported by a valid reason and appropriate documentation. Re-examination/re-test will not be an automatic entitlement and will be considered only with prior approval of the School Management.
- Question Paper Confidentiality:** Students must not photograph, copy, circulate or share the question paper or examination-related material on any social media or digital platform.
- Conveyance:** School conveyance will ply strictly as per the Examination Schedule. Parents are requested to ensure timely arrival and departure of students.
- Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM):** The PTM will be held on Saturday, 3rd October 2026. Parents are requested to attend the meeting as per the schedule communicated by the school.
- Valuables:** Students should not bring valuables or unnecessary belongings to school during examinations. The school will not be responsible for loss of personal items.
- Final Compliance:** Parents and students are requested to read all instructions carefully and strictly comply with the examination schedule, rules and directions issued by the school/examination department.
